I had the pleasure to see your patient, Joe Smith in consultation at our office. He has come for a follow up of COPD. Shortness of breath is reportedly at baseline. He continues regular use of tobacco. He is compliant with his bronchodilator therapy.

Review of Systems

- **Constitutional:** Recent weight gain and fatigue present. No fever, chills, recent weight loss or malaise.
- **Ear/Nose:** No tinnitus, otalgia, hearing loss, nasal congestion, rhinorrhea, epistaxis, ulcers, sinusitis, headache and vertigo.
- **Cardiovascular:** PND, orthopnea, angina, dyspnea, high blood pressure and swelling of ankles present. No palpitation, edema, claudication, PVD, syncope, MI, rheumatic fever or lightheadedness/dizziness.
- **Respiratory:** Cough and wheezing present. No sputum or hemoptysis.
- **Neurology:** Headache present. No weakness of extremities, giddiness, numbness, tingling, tremor, confusion, memory loss, mood changes, seizures or trouble walking.
- **Psychiatric:** No anxiety, depression, hallucination, delusions, aggressive behavior, wandering and crying.
- **Endocrine:** Polyuria, hypothyroidism and diabetes present. No polydipsia, heat intolerance, cold intolerance, hyperthyroidism, hot flushes or hair loss.

Physical Examination

- **Vital Signs:** Height is 5' 7", Weight is 188 lbs, BP is 122/70 mmHg, Pulse is 95 per min, PulseOx is 98% and BMI is 29.
- **Eyes:** PERRLA.
- **Nose:** Symmetric. Nares are patent bilaterally. No rhinorrhea. Turbinates are non-erythematous.
- **Throat:** Good general appearance and condition. No post-pharyngeal/oropharyngeal erythema and no tongue lesions. Palate is soft. No exudates. No tonsillar hypertrophy.
- **Neck:** No jugular venous distention. Thyromegaly absent. Cervical lymphadenopathy absent.
- **Lungs:** Breath sounds are equal bilaterally. Clear to auscultation. Normal resonance. No rales. No rhonchi. No wheezes.
- **Heart:** Regular rate. Regular rhythm. No murmurs. No rubs. Normal S1 and S2.



- **Abdomen:** Bowel sounds present. Soft. No tenderness. Abdominal obesity absent.
- **Extremities:** No evidence of extremity cyanosis or clubbing. No dependent distal extremity edema.
- **Skin:** Warm.
- **Neurologic:** Alert. Oriented to person, place and time.

Plan

- Counseled patient regarding tobacco cessation.
- Reviewed PFT.
- I have advised her to follow up in approximately 6 months.
